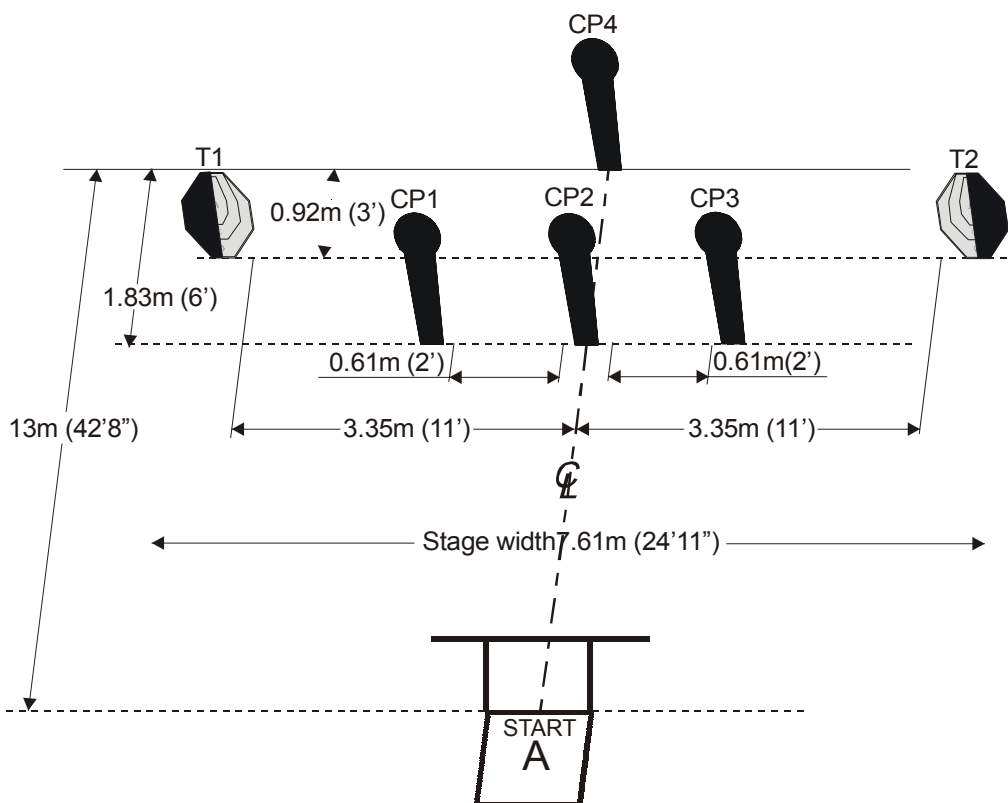

Course of Fire Type: Short Classifier Stage

Stage Procedure:

On start signal, from Area A, shoot only T1-T2 from above top board of 4-foot-by-4-foot frame, then shoot CP1 - CP4 from below board.

Scoring:	Comstock
Targets:	2 Classic, 4 Classic poppers
Possible Points:	40
Minimum Rounds:	8
Start Position:	Standing relaxed in Area A facing targets.
Start:	On audible signal
Stop:	Last shot
Penalties:	As per current edition IPSC rules



SETUP NOTES: Set paper to 1.52m (5 feet) to top of target. Area A is 4 feet by 4 feet (1.22m x 1.22m). 4-foot-by-4-foot (1.22m x 1.22m) frame is made out of 2x4's (5cm x 10cm). Place an 8-foot-long (2.44m) 2x4 (5cm x 10cm) flat over the top of the frame allowing an equal distance to overhang at both ends. This will be the board that poppers must be engaged under. Hard cover on T1 and T2 is as shown: it covers half of the target from top to bottom, as shown.
